dent exactly as they did. His advice to the girls was to repeat the Lord's Prayer and put up a cross in their room if the incident should occur again.

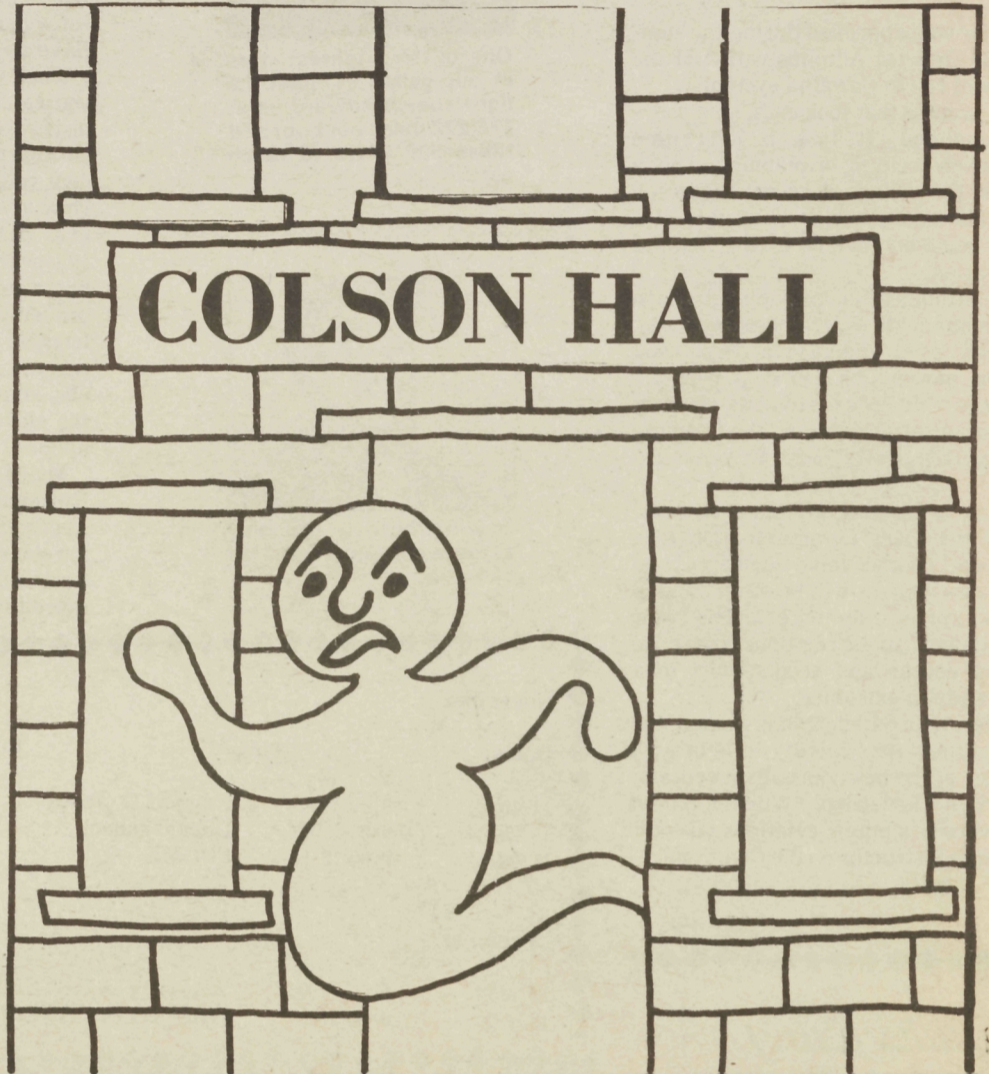
